Dear Sixth Grade Parents,

Plans are underway for your child's attendance at Camp Cuyamaca the week of **January 30 to** February 3, 2023. Trained outdoor-education teachers will guide our students in the study of conservation, nature, and science. Lessons incorporate trail experiences and citizen scientist projects to create hands-on learning that is meaningful, memorable, and fun. For many students the overnight experience transforms how they feel about science and themselves as learners. CMS teachers will accompany our six graders to camp, and will remain with them during the week. The cost for the weeklong program is \$375. This includes camp fee, insurance, and transportation to and from camp.

Regardless of vaccination status, before arriving at camp, all students must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test, or proof of a positive COVID-19 test or diagnosis within the last 90 days. More information about COVID-19 testing can be found here FAQ COVID-19.

Please return as soon as possible (no later than Dec. 5) to your child's Advisory teacher:

- 1. The <u>Health and Registration form</u> must be completed and signed by the parent.
- 2. Camp fees of \$375 must be fully paid at the time of registration. Forms without payment cannot be processed. Camp Cuvamaca will not accept late registrations. Firm deadline
