



The Islander Sports Foundation (ISF) sponsors the Middle School Sports program that is open to all students grades 6 through 8 who attend school or reside in Coronado. The Middle School Sports program strives to offer three seasons of well-organized, fun, healthy, and social physical activities that complement academic priorities and respond to a breadth of student athletic and sporting interests.

The values guiding the middle school sports program are participation, teamwork, effort, and healthy competition. Some sports offer multiple teams providing different levels of competition based on an assessment of the athlete's ability at the start of the season. All teams should expect to meet two to three times a week for the duration of the season with practice locations around Coronado.

Fees

The Middle School Sports program does not receive any state or school funding and relies entirely on athletes paying a \$200 fee to participate in each sport. The participation fees enable ISF to provide management, coaches, equipment, uniforms, and insurance. Some scholarships are available for students who complete a scholarship application.

Individual players are responsible for their personal gear (as specified for each sport) and for transportation to all practices and games.

Schedules

The Middle School Sports program Athletic Director will contact parents of registered players prior to the start of the season providing basic information about practice and game schedules. The specific schedule of games will be shared and posted on the ISF website once the School's league meets to determine the season's game schedule.

Some of the Middle School Sports teams compete against other middle schools requiring travel around the San Diego area. Students are responsible for securing transportation to any away games. Occasionally the scheduled game time will require athletes to have an early dismissal from school. Students will have an excused absence for the time missed due to sports games but are still responsible for any assigned schoolwork.

Registration

Any middle-school aged student in Coronado can enroll in CMS Sports by completing the online registration information available at www.islandersportsfoundation.com.

- Click on the More Tab
- Under Registration, select Middle School
- You will be redirected to another website, www.athleticclearance.com, to complete the registration process
- Select CA
- New users create an account, return users login to your account
- Select Start Clearances Here
- Select year, school, and sport. Be sure to select Coronado Middle School from the lengthy drop down menu (clicking on Coronado CIF will register you for High School Sports, not Middle School)
- Pay Online, or by Check or Cash (at the CMS office).

Registration also requires athletes to submit an athletic physical form signed by their medical provider and dated after June 1. A \$200 fee payment per sport is also required prior to the start of the season. Signed physical forms and checks for payment can be submitted at the Coronado Middle School office at 550 F Avenue in Coronado, CA. Registration, payment and signed physical form must be received prior to the first practice in order to participate in the sport. No exceptions allowed.
