Exploring possible 6th Grade Physical Education Online / Hybrid Class for 2017-2018

Dear 5th Grade Families,

In a continued effort to provide our students with personalized educational opportunities, CMS is exploring the possibility of offering a 6th grade online/in-class “hybrid” physical education class for the 2017-2018 school year. This course is for students who desire an alternative, more flexible physical education experience. The course curriculum meets California Standards and will mirror the current 6th grade physical education course content. The method of delivery, however, will be primarily online with some class meetings on the CMS campus throughout the year. The class size is limited, so if there are more interested students than space available, your child may not have the opportunity to be registered in the class. Additionally, **students who are self-starters, work well independently, have strong technology skills, and have maintained an A or B average during his/her 5th grade year will be most equipped for success in this course.**

- **Class time:** Monday through Friday, Period 7, 2:03 pm- 3:00 pm. (Wednesday, Minimum Day 12:40 pm- 1:20 pm.). With the exception of a few times a month, students will be dismissed from school at the end of period 6 – 2:00 p.m. On days the teacher will be meeting with students for the class, the students will remain on campus and be dismissed at the end of period 7, 3:00 p.m./ Wed. 1:20 pm. The on campus meeting days will be determined and provided to parents and students at the beginning of the school year. We will be targeting consistent days to meet on campus throughout the year. **Note:** there will be several meeting days during the first six weeks of school.
- **Transportation:** CMS does not provide bus service at this time of day. Please note, the expectation is for parents to transport or be comfortable with the mode of transportation their child will use to and from class.
- **Location:** The expectation is for the students to complete their online course work at home. Required class meetings will be held on CMS physical education facilities.
- **Commitment:** Students will end their day after period 6, 2:00 pm rather than 3:00 pm. (Wednesday, 12:40 pm rather than 1:20 pm.) On scheduled on-campus meeting days, students will remain at CMS until the end of the school day.
- **Who should apply:** Students who are motivated, self-starters and want to have flexibility in their daily schedule for outside athletics or activities. Students who seek an alternative approach to on campus PE.
- **Course content** is provided via CUSD’s learning management system, PowerSchool/Haiku. Students will complete approximately 8 modules (units) during the school year. Assignments range from creating videos, exercise logs, online assessments, and in class activities (schedule TBD) All work is submitted online.
