**Community Service: ( 2 points for every hour served - REQUIRED)**

Community service projects require initiative, planning, self-discipline and organization. It may be completed individually or as a group; however, each student who applies for the award must submit a goal and final report. The first step is to come up with a project of interest to you. You can do multiple projects during the year for this award. If you need suggestions for projects, please see the staff member in the library. When submitting your projects with the application, please follow the format in Example A. On your project description, please include the information listed in Example B.
